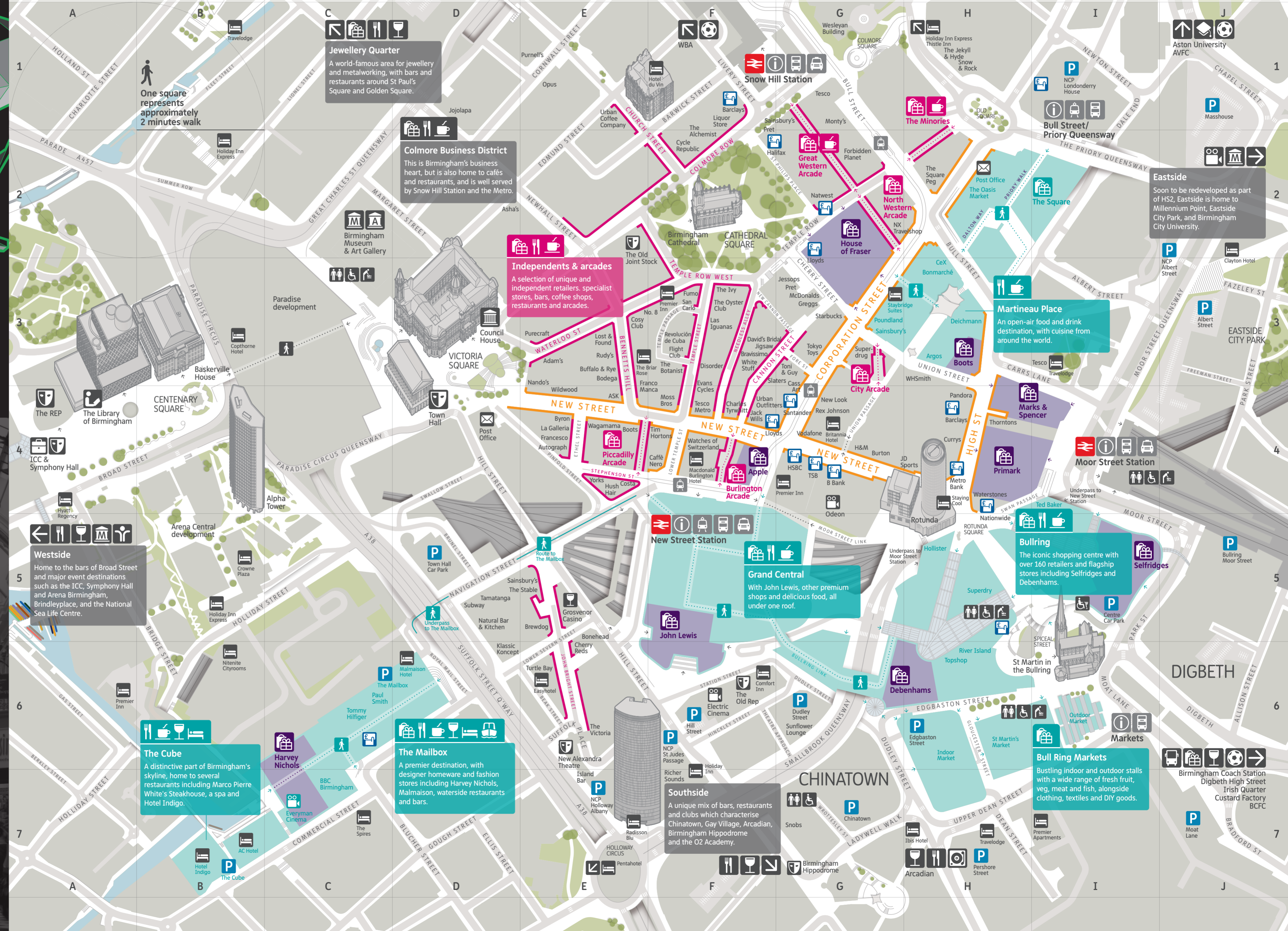
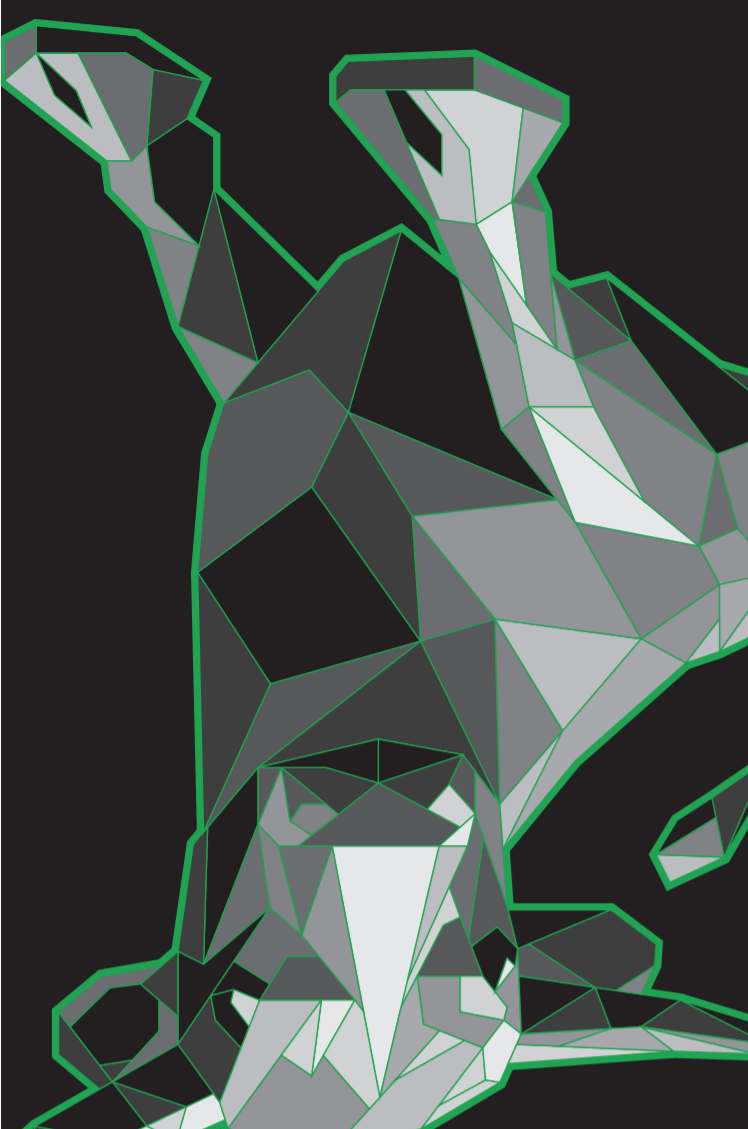

## Independents & arcades

**Great Western Arcade**  
Home to a variety of independent retailers such as Loki Wine, Miss Macaroon, Projekt 21, and Goodlife Barbers, this picturesque arcade oozes Victorian charm.

**Piccadilly Arcade**  
Located opposite New Street Station, Piccadilly Arcade is home to an eclectic mix of independent stores. Smithsonian Gifts is one of Birmingham's best-loved independent gift stores, while nearby Faculty Coffee prepares high-quality hot drinks and sells a range of coffee beans and equipment.

**Stephenson Street and Pinfold Street**  
Home to the bars of Broad Street and major event destinations such as the ICC, Symphony Hall and Arena Birmingham, Brindleyplace, and the National Sea Life Centre.

**Westside**  
Home to the bars of Broad Street and major event destinations such as the ICC, Symphony Hall and Arena Birmingham, Brindleyplace, and the National Sea Life Centre.

**John Bright Street**  
Some of Birmingham's best bars and restaurants can be found on this historic city centre street. Cherry Reds, Turtle Bay, BrewDog, and The Stable are among the highlights for a night out or lunch with friends.

**Waterloo Street and Temple Row**  
The city centre's booming dining quarter features menu options and drinks selections from around the world. Taking pride of place on Temple Row is The Ivy Restaurant. Home to the Michelin-starred Adam's restaurant, Waterloo Street is also host to the grand interiors of the Lost & Found, Sabai Sabai and Cosy Club.

**Bennetts Hill and Temple Row**  
The latest addition to the city is The Oyster Club by Adam Stokes on Temple Street, which sits opposite the legendary restaurant San Carlo along with The Botanist, Las Iguanas plus Everyman Barbers. On Bennetts Hill you can also find the Indian Streatery, Sun on the Hill, and South American-inspired Bodega.

**Jewellery Quarter**  
A world-famous area for jewellery and metalworking, with bars and restaurants around St Paul's Square and Golden Square.

**Colmore Business District**  
This is Birmingham's business heart, but is also home to cafes and restaurants, and is well served by Snow Hill Station and the Metro.

**Independents & arcades**

**Grand Central**

**Bulling**  
The iconic shopping centre with over 160 retailers and flagship stores including Selfridges and Debenhams.

**The Cube**  
A distinctive part of Birmingham's skyline, home to several restaurants including Marco Pierre White's Steakhouse, a spa and Hotel Indigo.

**The Mailbox**  
A premier destination, with designer homeware and fashion stores including Harvey Nichols, Malmison, waterside restaurants and bars.

**Southside**  
A unique mix of bars, restaurants and clubs which characterise Chinatown, Gay Village, Arcadian, Birmingham Hippodrome and the O2 Academy.

**Bull Ring Markets**  
Busting indoor and outdoor stalls with a wide range of fresh fruit, veg, meat and fish, alongside clothing, textiles and DIY goods.
